



Dear Scouter:

In the past, the Silver Beaver Selection Committee has received several nomination forms with missing or incomplete information. Unfortunately, this means that several deserving nominees may have gone unrecognized. The Selection Committee has developed some guidelines to assist you in completing the nomination form.

To complete section A, ask the nominee or spouse for information on the nominee's youth Scouting history. The nominee's adult information can be completed with the Pack/Troop/Crew training or advancement chair. In some cases, the Chartered Organization can help with these positions and dates. Several units have their entire adult leader corps fill out Scouting history forms, so that this information is available.

Section B asks for the nominee's information on church, civic, fraternal, youth service (other than Scouting), professional or business, and other outstanding or unusual service.

To complete the church activities section, someone in your unit/district will know the nominee's religious affiliation. If you don't know someone to help with the information, call the church office where someone will be able to tell you what their church activities include. For civic information, find out if the nominee is involved in local politics or any community service organizations (Junior League, Food Banks, the American Red Cross), if they have held any offices or helped in those organizations. Fraternal organizations include , but are not limited to, International Foresters, Eagle's, Lion's, Masonic Organizations, Sertoma, Toastmaster's, Kiwanis, and Elks Lodge..

Youth service would include coaching youth sports, PTA's, PTO's, parent supported school activities (band parents, after prom committees, etc.).

The professional or business section should be completed with information about any organizations that the nominee may be a member of, for example, trade unions, educational associations and/or business organizations.

The complete the other outstanding or unusual service section; include anything noteworthy that has not already been mentioned.

Thank you for submitting complete and accurate nomination forms. We have many Scouters who deserve the most prestigious award a council can give, the Silver Beaver Award.
