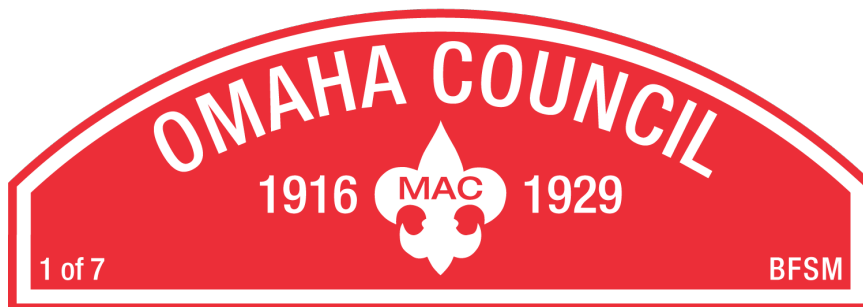

Prior to 1970, Boy Scout Councils used red and white patches on their left shoulder to identify them. These were known as Red & White Strips. To celebrate the rich history of the Mid-America Council, the Batchelder Family Scout Museum & Education Center has created a set of historic Red & White Strip patches. There will be seven patches that will make up the set. Each patch represents one of the councils that make up the current Mid-America Council. From 2010 to 2016 a new Red & White Strip will be issued each year leading up to the Mid-America Council's 100th Anniversary!
