

Would you like to spend a weekend at Little Sioux Scout Ranch and help out – but not have too much to do? Come be a camp host. The 2012 Calendar is open.

Check out the description of duties below. The remainder of the time you can help the ranger with small projects, or just sit back and relax or go fishing etc. You are welcome to bring your family along on this adventure as well.

Some of the things you will need to do are:

- Check in units on Friday and insure 2 deep leadership for each unit, collect health forms and tour permits, roster of who is in camp.
- Escort the units to their campsite/cabin
- Check unit into their campsite/cabin
- Confirm unit check out date and time
- If tent camping – find out location of their camp
- If going hiking –have them let you know in case someone gets hurt
- Perform a Saturday morning patrol of camp
- Checking key areas and buildings in camp
- Perform an afternoon unit check
- Direct people to points in camp if they ask
- Perform a Saturday night patrol of camp and unit checks
- Perform a Sunday morning patrol of camp (before units checkout)

This does not take much time and the rest of the weekend is yours to go fishing or just sit back and relax. You can tent camp, bring your camper and stay in the campground OR you can stay in the camp host room with two twin beds, a microwave, small refrigerator, crock pot, toaster and T.V. (bring DVD's to watch because there is no reception in the welcome center). There is also a grill outside you can use.

Our goal is to have someone at camp every weekend. This helps the rangers so they can continue with their normal work.
